Q1 Highlights:

- Postponement of deliveries in Vinghøg led to drop in revenue and EBITDA in Q1
- Order backlog increased to MNOK 690
- SOASA expecting revenue of approximately MNOK 550 in 2008, with EBITDA between MNOK 70 and MNOK 80.
- MNOK 4.8 (22.8 %) drop in other operating expenses in Q1-08 compared to Q1-07

- *Steady production and sales of night goggles and sniper sights in addition to the NOK 58 million contract of night goggles.*
- *On schedule on the development of a laser target designator Norwegian and Swedish armed forces*

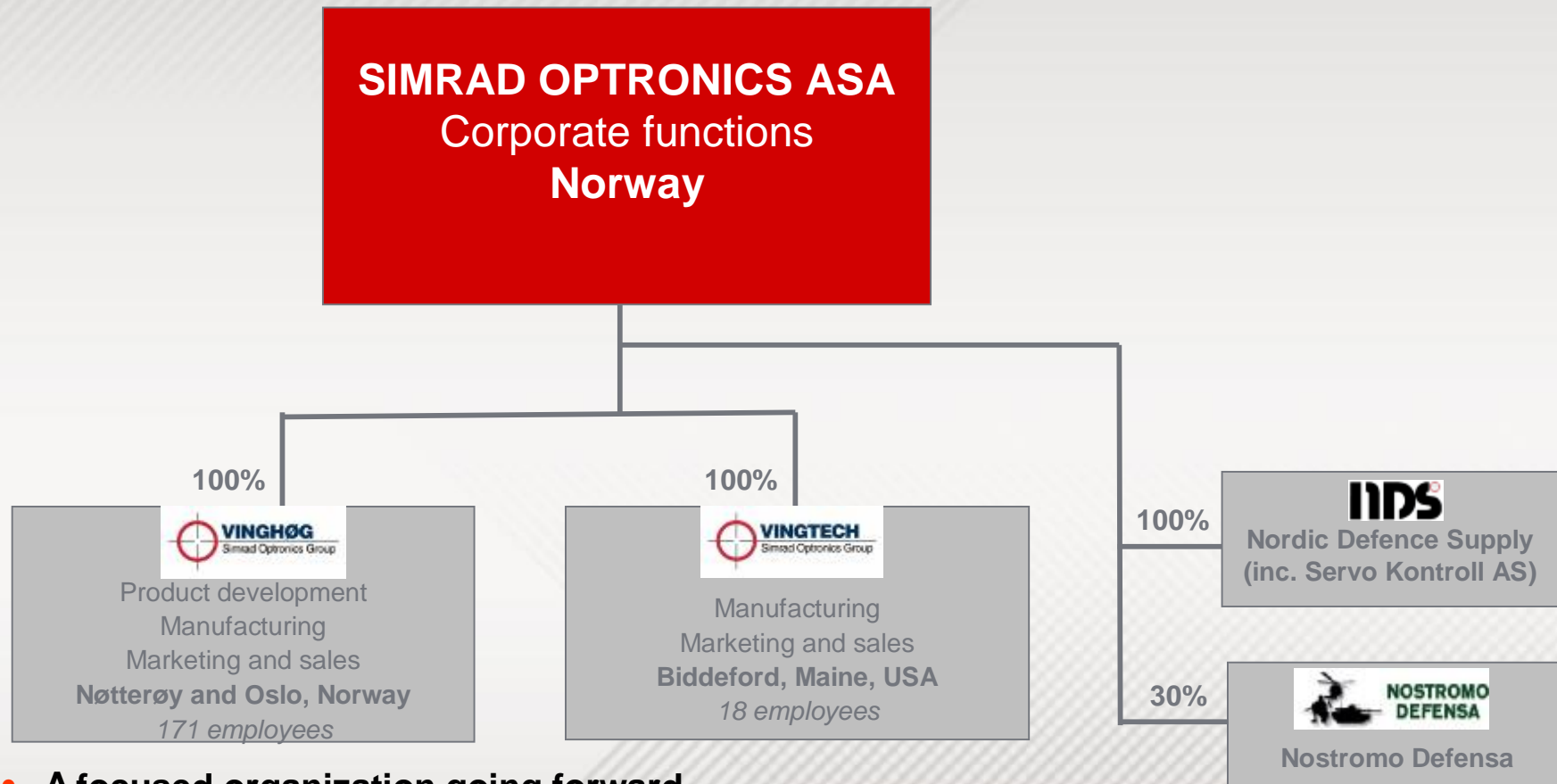


Operational developments in Q1 - II

- Weapon Improvement Systems
 - *Steady order flow, but a little less than last year so far.*
 - *On time with deliveries*
- Vehicle Systems
 - *The M109 contract was finalized and delivered in Q1 08.*
 - *Second Vingtaqs II systems including stabilization on track.*
- UAV
 - *Nostroma Defensa has received an important contract.*

- A structure for growth

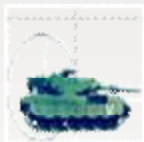
US Subsidiary , VingTech Corp.

- Activities:
 - Perform sale and assembly of Simrad Optronics' Group products in the US market
 - Develop own products together with the end-user and other defense partners in the US
 - Enter the homeland security market
- Progress to date:
 - Full production for RWS CROWS
 - Already some sales of Weapon improvement products
 - Received ISO approval
- Management estimates:
 - Turn over in 2008 will be close to \$ 20 million. Expected to increase over the next years

Industrial Cooperation agreement with SAAB

- SOASA has entered in to an industrial cooperation agreement with SAAB AB
- The agreement includes a set up of a joint venture company in Norway if Norway purchase JAS GRIPEN fighters
- SAAB and SOASA have identified possible programs for the first 10 years to more than seven billion NOK, that is covered under this agreement.
- The identified business areas includes among other:
 - tactical UAV
 - advanced electro optics
 - various platforms for radars and missiles.
- One of the industrial reasons for the merger between Vinghøg and SOASA was to position us better for the offset market. This agreement proves that we are able to achieve that.

2008 Priorities – Status Report

- Increase sales – Maintain margins
 - Temporary setback, but will be achieved during 08
 - Already reduced delayed deliveries with 25 % to date since end Q1.
 - SOASA expecting revenue of approximately MNOK 550 in 2008, with EBITDA between MNOK 70 and MNOK 80
- Establish new sales channels in one or two regions
 - On track, news expect to be released Q4
- Further develop our US subsidiary Vingtech Corp
 - Positive development during Q1, achieved a good assembly capacity and ISO certificate.

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Order Backlog and market outlook

- Order backlog
 - *Order backlog of NOK 690 million per 01.04.08*

- Marketed outlook
 - *The military marketed is still growing.*
 - *The demand for SOASA products are still high*
 - *The development of new sales channels is on track*
